  - 2. how attending the conference will benefit you personally
  - 3. how you will disseminate your learning from the conference in your local teaching community

NB: If you wish to submit your statement in video or audio format, you will need to upload your media file to a cloud-based account, such as YouTube, Dropbox or Google Drive and send us the link.

Please also submit a professional photo for inclusion in the conference programme if you win (remember to smile!)
