## How to ... get to Iasi

### It's easier than you think!

Iasi International Airport has three terminals and 3 airlines operate from here. There are 19 direct flights that can take you to Iasi. Alternatively, you can connect via Bucharest, and then fly to Iasi. There are at least three flights from Bucharest to Iasi every day.

### BLUE AIR

Blue Air currently flies to and from 9 destinations: Italy (Rome, Milan, Torino), United Kingdom (London Luton), Spain (Barcelona), France (Paris), Belgium (Brussels) and Germany (Munich and Köln). However, their winter schedule has not yet been published, therefore you will not be able to book your flight with Blue Air until the end of April 2018.

### WIZZ AIR

Wizz Air offers cheap flights to and from Cyprus (Larnaca), Israel (Tel Aviv), Italy (Venice, Rome, Bergamo, Bologna and Catania), United Kingdom (London), Denmark (Billund), the Netherlands (Eindhoven), Greece (Thessaloniki) and Germany (Dortmund).

### AUSTRIAN AIRLINES

There are 2 weekly flights from Vienna.

### How to reach Hotel International

Iasi International Airport, with three terminals, is located 7 kilometres from the city centre. Bus line 50 connects Iasi Airport with the centre of Iasi. The bus runs to the main square 'Piata Unirii' in the city, which is 15 minutes' walk from Hotel International. However, you might find it easier to take a taxi. The conference venue is approximately 15 minutes by taxi from the airport and the taxi fare is around €6.
